





Foundation President's Report

It was a bittersweet year in 2020 for the North Star Foundation. The start of the year saw the "Be My Valentine" campaign raise \$3,600. That led us to the COVID-19 pandemic and the unfortunate but necessary decision to cancel the 2nd Annual Itty-Bitty 0.5K Run. The Foundation had also planned a smaller version of the Itty-Bitty in Rawlins but that was canceled too due to the pandemic.

For a good portion of 2020 the Foundation tried to wait out the pandemic, however it was not going away anytime soon. It was time to start growing membership and sponsorships. In September the Foundation ran a "Friends and Family" campaign to have family and friends of staff join the foundation. Eight of the ten branches hit their benchmarks and we gained 326 new members while raising over \$1,700 in donations.

Then in November of 2020, the Foundation participated in the first annual Flags for Heroes campaign! This was the "cherry-on-top" for 2020. Flags were displayed at both Cheyenne locations and in Wellington. The display was patriotic and was commented on all over social media.
